All Members,

Simulated Environment – Consolidated Circular

Exchange periodically consolidates circulars issued by the department over the period to provide one single document to refer for various policy and operational matters.

Exchange had issued simulated environment consolidated circular dated July 03, 2020, which was compilation of earlier consolidation and relevant circulars issued by Exchange from April 01, 2019 to March 31, 2020.

Subsequently, various circulars were issued by the Exchange over the period of time. In the view of same, this Consolidated circular is prepared which is a compilation of subsequent circulars related to Simulated Environment in the Capital Market (CM), Futures & Options (FO), Currency Derivatives (CD) and Commodity Derivatives (CO) Segments of the Exchange issued during the period April 01, 2020 to March 31, 2023.

In this regards, members may please note the following:

A) The timings for the daily simulated trading sessions in the CM, FO, CD and CO segment are as follows:

For CM Segment:

For FO, CD and CO segments:

#Exchange support through helpdesk (call / emails) for the environment shall be available only upto 7:30 PM on regular trading days.

- B) Members desirous of participating in the simulated environment shall be governed by the various circulars / communications / instructions / directions issued by the Exchange from time to time and such member shall remain compliant in this regard. Any non-compliance shall invite disciplinary action by the Exchange which will be initiated in accordance with the applicable Exchange Byelaws, Rules and Regulations.

- D) No information has been rescinded for this consolidation, however, in future for any rescinded information, members may note the below:

Annexure 1

Important instructions

- 1. The Simulated Environment shall be available on all regular live trading days.
- 2. All members eligible to trade in respective segment in live market shall be enabled for the daily simulated trading sessions with their existing user ids, IP and Box Id mapping i.e. members can use their production network connectivity itself for participating in the Simulated Environment.
- 3. Simulated Environment is available to all members in CM, FO, CD and CO segments from Noncolocation connectivity.
- 4. Members can access only CM, FO and CD segments Simulated Environment from colocation facility too. Members shall not be allowed to connect to the Commodity Segment Simulated environment from colocation facility.
- 5. Members may kindly note that simulated environment is a replica of the Live environment only in terms of functionality and not in terms of scale, capacity and infrastructure. Accordingly, it should be used for functionality testing and not for performance testing.
- 6. The Member masters / User id Masters and Master files i.e. Security.txt / contract.txt / participant.txt / MTBT stream info files etc. of the respective segments are replicated from the live environment on a periodic basis in the simulated environment. The required master files for participating in the simulated environment can be downloaded from the following link: https://ims.connect2nsccl.com/MemberPortal/view/testMrktHome.jsp or https://enit.nseindia.com/MemberPortal/view/testMrktHome.jsp The date mentioned as part of the master files name in the respective segment, shall indicate the EOD that has been replicated.
- 7. Members may note that post successful mocks of major changes / versions releases and its subsequent roll out in Live Market Environment, the Exchange shall endeavour to replicate the same in Simulated Market Environment in less than 2 weeks' time. The Exchange shall provide information of such updates, as and when they take place, through Member Portal. In order to know the last updated date of replication of data from Live market environment to Simulated environment, members may refer to the link as provided below :-

8. The default password to login shall be same as applicable for live market as mentioned below:

9. Members are required to set their branch / user limits from their corporate manager terminal in the respective segments, prior to placing orders in the simulated environment.



- 10. Refer to Exchange circular download ref no <u>NSE/MSD/44949</u> dated July 08, 2020 for "important guidelines and scope of Exchange-provided technical support".
- 11. Members may test their NNF application in simulated environment once development is complete and has been successfully tested in the Exchange test market environment. Any API related queries should be tested and raised in the test market environment only and not in the Simulated environment.

 - a. While sending mail pertaining to simulated environment, members are advised to prefix

 - b. Members are requested to send requests via email pertaining to following activities with the details of User ID and segment for Exchange action.

 - ii. CTCL conversion
 - iii. Password Reset for corporate manger user id
 - iv. Unlocking of corporate manager user id
 - c. In case of any technical queries w.r.t. Simulated Environment, members are required to send email with the following minimum details for Exchange analysis, in absence of which the Exchange may not be able to assist you for early resolution of your query.
 - i. Member Code, Member Name
 - ii. Segment, User ID, BOX ID and IP
 - iii. Details of login protocol used i.e. NEAT Adaptor / Direct Connection
 - iv. Query in brief along with details of exchange order no., trade no., error code, reason codes, screenshots of error etc.
 - v. Contact details i.e. Name and contact no of the concerned person with whom our technical team can connect in case of any discussion required on the said query.
 - vi. Please note that since the queries are technical in nature and will require time for analysis, the Exchange SLA shall be atleast 7 working days in such cases. The expected timelines for resolution shall be communicated to the members accordingly.
- 13. Trades resulting from these sessions shall not attract any obligation in terms of funds and / or securities pay-in and/or pay-out. Members are requested not to transfer any data files for this session.
- 14. Exchange also has a facility to provide liquidity for participating members to test their Non-NEAT Frontend (NNF) applications. The facility is available for Capital Market (CM), Futures & Options (FO), Currency Derivatives (CD) and Commodity Derivatives (CO) segments of the Exchange from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM on all trading days when Simulated Environment is available.
