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Dear Members,

This is further to Exchange circular no. NSE Circular NSE/CMO/0013/2000 dated May 12 2000, NSE/CMO/0235/2005 dated August 24 2005, and NSE/CMO/025/2011 dated May 17, 2011 on CTCL undertaking and Decision Support Tools / Algorithms for trading through Non-Neat front end respectively.

Trading members have represented to the Exchange to facilitate an early approval of various Non Neat id front end products for trading on the Exchange platform. Accordingly, to facilitate an efficient and speedy approval it is proposed to accept member applications through electronic mode. As such a facility is provided in ENIT to accept the requests for the following NNF applications:

- 1. CTCL Approval Process
- 2. Algorithm Approval Process
- 3. Enablement of Non Neat id

The procedure for submitting the application through ENIT is detailed in the Annexure

Further, it may be noted that digital signature is imperative for accepting the applications through ENIT at the Exchange. Hence, it is mandatory that all the applications sent electronically through NSE ENIT contain digital signature as allotted by the Exchange to Authorized personnel of the trading firm.

The circular is effective from July 12, 2011.




Member can login to ENIT through corporate manager user id by entering User ID and password




1. NNF Process – CTCL undertaking submission:

CTCL undertaking submission is applicable for members who avail CTCL facility for the first time. Subsequently member is required to submit only CTCL documentation ie Network diagram and Board resolution with each vendor.

- For Members wanting to submit CTCL Undertaking, the user can view the Undertaking Submission option under 'NNF Process'.
- Members are required to fill in the required details as required in the format.




Members who have already submitted CTCL undertaking and now applying for CTCL through a different vendor, need not furnish CTCL undertaking afresh. However, they are required to furnish the additional details such as name of the vendor, Notarized network diagram and Copy of Board resolution.




On successful submission of the required documents member would receive a reference number for all future correspondence with respect to the request furnished. Members would be able to view the requests with updated status in **MIS report.**

Members are required to submit CTCL undertaking in physical form only after the status of the request in the MIS report is updated from "submitted" to "Documents Awaited".




2.NNF Process -CTCL approval - In-House CTCL Application


Members who intend to develop CTCL application software through non-empanelled vendor or In-House are required to furnish the application as given below:



Additionally, members are required to provide the write up on the software.




On successful submission of the required documents member would receive a reference number for all future correspondence with respect to the request furnished. Members would be able to view the requests with updated status in **MIS report.**




3.NNF Process -CTCL approval - Algo Application


Members desirous of seeking approval for 'Approved Algorithms' shall make an application to the Exchange by furnishing the required details as given below:

On successful submission of the required documents member would receive a reference number for all future correspondence with respect to the request furnished. Members would be able to view the requests with updated status in **MIS report.**




4. Procedure for requesting for Non Neat User id without NEAT login:

The procedure for requesting for Non-neat user ids without NEAT login facility is given below: Member can either request for an altogether a new user id or request for conversion of an existing user id for the above purpose.

The option is provided under:

- Exchange>User request>Without Digital sign>Request for new non-neat user
- Exchange>User request>Without Digital sign>conversion for non-neat user



On successful submission of the request member would receive a reference number for all future correspondence with respect to the request furnished. Members would be able to view the requests in **NON-neat Request status.**
