BIDDER'S UNDERTAKING FOR REVISION FORM

I/We (on behalf of joint bidders, if any) confirm that the Acknowledgement slip for my/our bids are enclosed for the revisions which are being requested. I/We agree to be bound by all the terms & conditions mentioned in the Bid cum Application Form submitted earlier by me/us.

I/We (on behalf of joint bidders, if any) authorise you to reject this Bid Revision Form, in case any of the details of my existing Bids as appearing on the electronic book building system do not tally with the details given in this Revision Form.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING UP THE BID REVISION FORM

1. Name of sole/ First Bidder should be exactly the same as it appears in the depository records.
2. Please ensure that the Bid Options provided are in the same order as that provided in the Bid Cum Application Form submitted earlier.
3. In case there is no change in the particular Bid Option, please write "NO CHANGE". In case you want to cancel the Bid Option, please write "CANCELLED".
4. In case of Bidders specifying more than one Bid Option, the Total Amount payable must be calculated for the highest of three options, at Bid Price. Total amount to be paid must be calculated net of total amount paid at the time of submission of Bid Cum Application Form. Bidders, please ensure that your Bank has notified an SCSB Branch in the city where Bid-cum-Application Form is being submitted.
Revision of Bids in case of Revision of Price Band: In case of an upward revision in the Price Band, Retail Individual Bidder who had Bid at Cut-off Price could either (i) revise their Bid or (ii) shall make additional payment based on the cap of the revised Price Band (such that the total amount i.e., original Bid Amount plus additional payment does not exceed ₹ 200,000 if the Bidder wants to continue to Bid at Cut-off Price), with the members of the Syndicate/Registered Brokers/RTA/CDPs to whom the original Bid was submitted. In case the total amount (i.e., original Bid Amount plus additional payment) exceeds ₹ 200,000, the Bid will be considered for allocation under the Non-Institutional Portion in terms of the RHP. If, however, the Bidder does not either revise the Bid or make additional payment and the Offer Price is higher than the cap of the Price Band prior to revision, the number of Equity Shares Bid for, shall be adjusted downwards for the purpose of Allotment, such that no additional amount would be required to be blocked and the Bidder is deemed to have approved such revised Bid at Cut-off Price. (i) In case of a downward revision in the Price Band, announced as above, Retail Individual Bidders who has bid at Cut-off Price, could either revise their Bid or the excess amount blocked at the time of bidding would be unblocked from the ASBA Account after the Allotment is finalised.
5. Only the First Bidder is required to sign the Bid cum Application Form /Revision Form. Thumb impressions and signatures other than in the languages specified in the Eighth Schedule to the Constitution of India must be attested by a Magistrate or a Notary Public or a Special Executive Magistrate under official seal. If the First Bidder is not the account holder, ensure that the Bid cum Application Form is signed by the ASBA account holder. Signature of the ASBA Account holder is mandatory.
6. **Other Instructions:** a. Revision to Bids must be made only in the prescribed Revision Form, as applicable; b. Revision Form must be completed in full, in BLOCK LETTERS in ENGLISH. Bidders should note that the Members of the Syndicate/ SCSBs/Collecting Agents/Registered Brokers/RTAs/CDPs will not be liable for errors in data entry due to incomplete or illegible Revision Forms; c. Ensure that Acknowledgement Slip for your Bid has and any other applicable documents in support of the revision are attached with the Revision Form; and d. Bidders shall only be required to offer instruction to block the revised amount, in excess of their original blocked amount, based on the cap of the revised Price Band upon an upward revision of their Bid.
