BIDDER'S UNDERTAKING FOR REVISION FORM

I/We (on behalf of joint applicants, if any) confirm that the Acknowledgement slip for my/our bids are enclosed for the revisions which are being requested. I/We agree to be bound by all the terms & conditions mentioned in the Bid cum Application Form submitted earlier by me/us.

I/We (on behalf of joint applicants, if any) authorize you to reject this Bid Revision Form, in case any of the details of my existing Bids as appearing on the electronic book building system do not tally with the details given in this Revision Form.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING UP THE BID REVISION FORM

1. Name of Sole/ First Bidder should be exactly the same as it appears in the depository records.
2. Please ensure that the Bid Options provided are in the same order as that provided in the Bid Cum Application Form submitted earlier.
3. In case there is no change in the particular Bid Option, please write "NO CHANGE". In case you want to cancel the Bid Option, please write "CANCELLED".
4. Total Amount payable must be calculated for the highest of three options, at Bid Price. Total amount to be paid must be calculated net of total amount paid at the time of submission of Bid Cum Application Form. Bidders, please ensure that your Bank has notified an SCSB Branch in the city where Application Form is being submitted. **Revision of Bids in case of Revision of Price Band:** In case of an upward revision in the Price Band, Retail Individual Bidders who had Bid at Cut-off Price could either (i) revise their Bid or (ii) shall make additional payment based on the cap of the revised Price Band (such that the total amount i.e., original Bid Amount plus additional payment does not exceed ₹ 2,00,000 if the Bidder wants to continue to Bid at Cut-off Price), with the members of the Syndicate/Registered Brokers/RTA/CDPs to whom the original Bid was submitted. In case the total amount (i.e., original Bid Amount plus additional payment) exceeds ₹ 2,00,000/-, the Bid will be considered for allocation under the Non-Institutional Portion in terms of the RHP. If, however, the Bidder does not either revise the Bid or make additional payment and the Offer Price is higher than the cap of the Price Band prior to revision, the number of Equity Shares Bid for shall be adjusted downwards for the purpose of Allotment, such that no additional payment would be required from the Bidder and the Bidder is deemed to have approved such revised Bid at Cut-off Price. (i) In case of a downward revision in the Price Band, announced as above, Retail Individual Bidders, who have bid at Cut-off Price could either revise their Bid or the excess amount blocked at the time of bidding would be unblocked from the ASBA Account.
5. Only the first Bidder is required to sign the Bid cum Application Form /Revision Form. Thumb impressions and signatures other than in the languages specified in the Eighth Schedule to the Constitution of India must be attested by a Magistrate or a Notary Public or a Special Executive Magistrate under official seal. If the first applicant is not the account holder, ensure that the Bid cum Application Form is signed by the account holder.
6. **Other Instructions:** a. Revision to Bids must be made only in the prescribed Revision Form, as applicable. b. Bids must be completed in full, in BLOCK LETTERS in ENGLISH. Bidders should note that the Syndicate Members/ SCSBs/Collecting Agents/Registered Brokers/RTA/CDP will not be liable for errors in data entry due to incomplete or illegible Revision Forms. c. Ensure that Acknowledgement slip for your Bid has and any other applicable documents in support of the Revision are attached with the Revision Form; and d. Bidders shall only be required to pay the amount in excess of their original Bid Amount (if any) upon an upward revision of their Bid.

* Our Company and the Selling Shareholders, in consultation with the BRLMs, may allocate up to 60% of the QIB Category to Anchor Investors at the Anchor Investor Offer Price, on a discretionary basis, subject to there being (i) a maximum of two Anchor Investors, where allocation in the Anchor Investor Portion is up to ₹ 100.00 million, (ii) minimum of two and maximum of 15 Anchor Investors, where the allocation under the Anchor Investor Portion is more than ₹ 100.00 million but up to ₹ 2,500.00 million, subject to a minimum Allotment of ₹ 50.00 million per Anchor Investor, and (iii) in case of allocation above ₹ 2,500.00 million under the Anchor Investor Portion, a minimum of five such investors and a maximum of 15 Anchor Investors for allocation up to ₹ 2,500.00 million, and an additional 10 Anchor Investors for every additional ₹ 2,500.00 million, subject to minimum allotment of ₹ 50.00 million per Anchor Investor. An Anchor Investor will make a minimum Bid of such number of Equity Shares, that the Bid Amount is at least ₹ 100.00 million. **This Offer is being made through the Book Building Process wherein 50% of the Offer will be available for allocation to QIBs on a proportionate basis, provided that the Anchor Investor Portion may be allocated on a discretionary basis. Further, not less than 15% of the Offer will be available for allocation on a proportionate basis to Non-Institutional Investors subject to valid Bids being received at or above the Offer Price. Further, not less than 35% of the Offer will be available for allocation to Retail Individual Investors in accordance with SEBI ICDR Regulations, subject to valid Bids being received at or above the Offer Price. Under-subscription, if any, in any category, except the QIB Category, would be met with spill-over from any other category or categories, as applicable, at the discretion of the Company and the Selling Shareholders in consultation with the BRLMs and the Designated Stock Exchange on a proportionate basis, subject to applicable laws.

***If the Bid is submitted in joint names, the Bid cum Application Form should contain only the name of the first Bidder whose name should also appear as the first holder of the depository account held in joint names. The signature of only the first Bidder would be required in the Bid cum Application Form and such first Bidder would be deemed to have signed on behalf of the joint holders.
