- We have received a show cause notice from SEBI regarding alleged non-compliance of provisions of Companies Act 2013 and erstwhile SEBI (Issue and Listing of Debt Securities) Regulations, 2008 relating to public offering of securities which may result in penal actions.

Concentration Risk:

- A significant portion of our advances in the microbanking segment are towards customers located in the states of Bihar and Uttar Pradesh. Further, a significant portion of our deposits from such customers are from the states and union territory of Maharashtra, NCT of Delhi, Uttar Pradesh and Haryana. We are currently significantly dependent on our microbanking segment, particularly joint liability group ("JLG") loans. - If we are unable to control the level of NPAs in our portfolio, our business, financial conditions, results of operations and cash flows could be adversely affected
- Our profit after tax declined from ₹ 1,118.15 million in Fiscal 2021 to ₹ 614.62 million in Fiscal 2022. 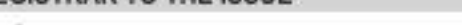
