For the Quarter ending on 30<sup>th</sup> June ,2021, the company has discontinued to make the provision of interest on loans from banks (excluding on the settlement entered with ARCs for specific loans which are assigned to them and also on the loans which are time barred under the law of limitation ).Had the company continued the said practice of making provision of interest on loans from banks for the quarter ended on 30<sup>th</sup> June,2021, the profit for the quarter would have been lower by Rs 36.55 lakhs and current liabilities would have been higher to that extent.
- 2. The Company has not assessed the impact of Effective Interest Method to the finance cost as per the requirement of Ind AS 109 'Financial Instruments and hence, the effect of the same, if any, on the financial results is not identifiable therefore, we are unable to comment upon its impact on the Financial results for the quarter ended June 30, 2021.
- 3. The Company has not evaluated the provisioning requirement of a loss allowance on its financial assets so as to give impact of impairment if any as per the expected credit loss method as per the requirement of Ind AS 109 'Financial Instruments' and hence, the effect of the same if any on the Financial Results is not identifiable therefore.
