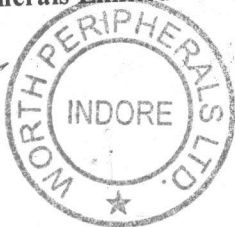

BJP's catch...

The BJP has clearly overplayed its hand and was finding it difficult to accommodate the TMC heavyweights since it is no longer in power, preferring to put all its eggs in the Suvendhu Adhikari basket. According to TMC sources, BJP leader Sabyasachi Dutta, former West Bengal Forest Minister Rajib Banerjee and Abhijit Mukherjee, son of former President Pranab Mukherjee, are likely to defect in Round II. The wheel has turned a full circle and just in time for the state panchayat polls.

SC postpones...

The top court also clarified that it will not entertain a petition in the matter to cancel the exam. The bench noted, how can we say don't conduct the exams at all? The court added that, "this has never happened. We can't entertain a request to waive the exam completely." At the beginning of the hearing, the top court asked the counsel representing AIIMS to consider postponing the exam by a month, which was scheduled on June 16. Justice Banerjee said, "Situation in Delhi has improved but in other places figures are high. Can't this be postponed by a month?" AIIMS counsel Dushyant Parashar submitted that if the exam is stayed then there will be an unprecedented crisis. He submitted that several doctors will be recruited by this exam and these petitioners can apply in the next September session exam. "If stay is granted there will be no doctors," said Parashar. The bench said, "You do this or we will pass order". Parashar sought time from the bench to come back with instructions. The bench asked him to revert at 12.30 p.m. today. After the hearing resumed in the matter, the bench passed the order postponing the exam by a month.

G7 1bn...

"The new US and UK commitments are a step in the right direction, but they don't go far enough, fast enough," said Alex Harris, director of government relations at Wellcome, a London-based science and health charitable foundation. "What the world needs is vaccines now, not later this year. At this historic moment, the G7 must show the political leadership our crisis demands," said Harris. "We urge G7 leaders to raise their ambition." Britain and the United States have, however, said their donations would come with no strings attached. British foreign minister Dominic Raab has warned that other countries were using vaccines as diplomatic tools to secure influence. "If the best G7 leaders can manage is to donate 1 billion vaccine doses then this summit will have been a failure," Oxfam's health policy manager Anna Marriott said, adding that the world would need 11 billion doses to end the pandemic. The race to bring an end to a pandemic that has killed around 3.9 million people globally and sown social and economic destruction will feature prominently at the three-day summit which began on Friday in the English seaside resort of Carbis Bay.

Trial in neutral country only way Jadhav could get relief: Rohatgi

Pak not trustworthy, says former Attorney General

After Pakistan's National Assembly approved a bill allowing Indian national Kulbhushan Jadhav to appeal against his conviction in the country's high courts, India's former Attorney General



Mukul Rohatgi on Friday said the only way Jadhav could get relief would be if the International Court allows his plea to be heard in a neutral country with a good judicial system. "We (India) should ask

the international court if the appeal can be heard in a neutral country which has a good judicial system. That probably is the only way Jadhav will get some relief. The judicial system is not trustworthy in Pakistan. By getting a lawyer from India, I don't think he will meet the end of justice," Rohatgi told ANI. The former Attorney General said he will take Pakistan's decision to allow Jhadav plea in High Courts with a 'pinch of salt', though he added that it's a 'small welcome step'.

"I personally feel that the judicial system and atmosphere in that country (Pakistan) is such that India is treated as an enemy. So I don't really think that Jadhav will get justice in an appeal just by getting an Indian lawyer. I don't think that will serve the purpose," he said. Rohatgi suggested that India should again make a plea at Human Rights Court and International Court of Justice for Jadhav's release as he was "wrongly arrested and illegally convicted without any rights".

Yadav also accused the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) government in the state of mishandling the Covid crisis, alleging costly treatment of coronavirus, negligence in treatment of black fungus, shortage of life-saving medicines and stalled development works. "There is no hope left for the people from the BJP government which is engaged in 'bandar baant'," he said in a statement issued here in Hindi.

MALAD BUILDING COLLAPSE Judicial inquiry into 'man-made disaster'

A Bombay High Court bench of Chief Justice Dipankar Datta and Justice Girish Kulkarni, observed that the building collapse at Malad which claimed 12 lives, including those of eight children, was a 'man-made disaster' and ordered a judicial enquiry into the incident. The bench told the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) on Friday that "the lives of citizens aren't so cheap that they can be left to die in such incidents". The bench was hearing a suo motu Public Interest Litigation (PIL) which was taken up after a building collapsed in Bhiwandi city in Thane district last year.

The judges also noted that from May 15 to June 10, 2021, there have been four instances of building collapse, two each in Mumbai and Ulhasnagar, killing 24 citizens and injuring 23 others. "What is happening? How many more lives will be lost?" Chief Justice Datta questioned BMC Counsel Anil Sakhare. Sakhare informed the bench that the land in Malvani belongs to the district collector, and the civic body doesn't have any control over the said land parcel. He went on to cite a government resolution claiming that the state has notified that the civic body would not be the planning authority of land parcels belonging to the district collector.

13 Naxals surrender in Bastar

SUKMA: Thirteen Naxals, including a couple, surrendered in two districts of Chhattisgarh's Bastar region on Friday, which was the last day of the outlawed movement's 'Jan Pituri week', police said. While eight ultras turned themselves in before police and CRPF officials in Sukma district, five surrendered in neighbouring Dantewada, they said. "Of the eight surrendered cadres, Vanjam Bheema is a member of the Naxals' platoon number 4 in section B and carried a reward of Rs 2 lakh on his head. His wife, Madavi Kalawati, a member of the Maoists' cultural outfit Chetna Natya Mandalai (CNM), also surrendered," Sukma Superintendent of Police KL Dhruv said.

Janpad CEO, 3 patwaris caught red handed with bribe money

Acting on the specific complaints of demanding bribe teams of Anti-corruption Bureau (ACB) carried out raids on the four different locations in the districts Balodabazar, Bastar and Balrampur, Kawardha and arrested three patwari and a Janpad CEO red handed. All the arrests were made on Friday. ACB team of Balodabazar, arrested accused Kulleshwar Gaiakwad (60), Chief Ex-

ecutive Officer Janpad Panchayat Bilaigarh for demanding a bribe of Rs 20,000. He was demanding kickback to clear the pending amount Rs 3 lakh of a contractor who carried out construction in a government school building. As the officer was not ready to release the pending amount without hush money, the victim complained the matter to ACB, after which a trap was laid and the Janpad CEO was arrested red handed on Friday from his official residence, an ACB officer said.
